The final deadline to submit your original essay is 11:59 p.m. on December 31, 2017.

The essay must be submitted in both WORD compatible and PDF formats attached to an email sent to KnightEssay@sarsandiego.org. The WORD compatible format copy will be used to count the number of words in the essay. The PDF format copy will be used by the judges of the essay.
