Thank you to our student planners and staff and the Bahia Resort for hosting a safe and fun Prom last Saturday night. Unfortunately, a Coast Guard maximum capacity on the boat combined with record-breaking ticket sales necessitated us putting some students on a waiting list for tickets on the last day of sales. We were able to work with the Bahia Belle and pare our excess chaperones to the number required, as well as reconsider number of vendors and space allotted to include all students on the waiting list. Nevertheless, we regret the stress and frustration the uncertainty caused, and we are committed to considering venues for our events which will not limit participation of eligible students. With Homecoming attracting more than 800 students, and Prom approaching 500, we will be researching venues that can hold that number of students (school site facilities and local spaces may not meet these criteria) as we move forward.

Summer School: CHS will be offering a limited summer school program for students in need of remediating failing grades to meet graduation requirements, with priority given to graduating seniors and rising 12th graders. Families with students encouraged to take summer school will be contacted by counselors. Summer School runs from June 19 through July 28 with mandatory attendance.
