We are proud to offer our students the opportunity to take the 2017 PSAT/NMSQT on the campus of Coronado High School. This year the PSAT will be administered to all students in grades 9, 10, 11, Wednesday, Oct. 11, at no charge. An official score report with a student's scores and detailed information on how to improve their academic skills will be mailed to you late December, along with information regarding counselor-led evening programs for parents to be held in January. These programs will assist you in interpreting the PSAT report and provide information about college planning.
