

Dear Islander Families,

Our CHS ASB is preparing for our Homecoming festivities, including spirit days, pep rally, community parade and class float competition; football game on Friday, November 3 vs. San Diego High School; halftime crowning of the Queen and King; and our dance on Saturday November 4th at the Ruben H. Fleet Center. We encourage ALL students to participate in float building and the dance. Students should join their class Facebook page for information on float building location and times. Some things to keep in mind about our Homecoming activities and dance:

- Homecoming Floats are a class competition and there are wonderful opportunities for peer bonding during building and the parade and half-time showcase. Community members generously offer to host float building at their homes. We remind our Islanders to participate positively in the activities and to be aware that undermining construction of classmates' floats and targeting or vandalizing private property (including eggs, water balloons) may result in police and/or school actions, with accompanying loss of privileges.
- We have been proud to host as many as 800 Islanders/guests at our Homecoming dance! This year, along with dancing, students will have access to the Fleet Center's video game exhibit. Even if you don't like dancing, there are activities for you and your friends.
- We encourage students to attend the dance with an inclusive group of friends. While we know that students may ask a guest or friend to the dance, students often report that arriving and attending with a group is the most fun.
- Students, please consider that public Homecoming "asks" or "proposals" may be stressful for you and your intended date, and may result in unintended social media posts and commentary. While there is a current trend among students to find creative ways to invite someone to the dance, be sure you are considering all the possible scenarios and emotions involved. Set you and your friend up for success!
- Homecoming, with potential costs associated with attire, meals, flowers, and transportation, can be expensive, and you may want to look for areas to spend less. Note that we will have heavy appetizers, desserts, and drinks at Homecoming. Homecoming is considered a less formal dance than prom as it relates to attire--we appreciate that students feel free to wear long or short dresses, pantsuits, Hawaiian shirts and khakis, ties, suits, and occasionally tuxes. Students in need of financial assistance for Homecoming may see Natalie Cruz in the Student Store.
- **Students must attend ALL classes on Friday of Homecoming (no one leaves early for the parade or parade preparation!) or they lose the privilege of participating in the parade/dance.**

Don't forget winter sports are fast approaching! If your son or daughter is interested in basketball, soccer or girls' water polo, please check the ISF website www.islandersportsfoundation.org for try-out times, schedules and much more. We are actively recruiting Islander girls interested in playing basketball or soccer.
