

CHS Islanders: Ten Tips for 2014-15!

1. **Register for School Online!** Online registration for all students is **open NOW**. All new and returning students must complete online registration at <http://coronadousd.net/parents-students/registration-enrollment/>. During the registration process, print the Affidavit Form. Bring the signed Affidavit and two proofs of residency to CHS on your assigned date.
 - a. Last Names A-K..... Monday 8/11 8:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m
 - b. Last Names L-Z..... Tuesday 8/12 8:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.
 - c. Make-ups..... Friday 8/15 8:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

For schedule change requests (NO guarantees!), fill out the form available in the front office, and be aware:

--Students *cannot* request to add or drop a course after September 12, 2014

--Students may NOT request specific teachers or periods for courses.

--Your entire schedule may need to be adjusted in order to accommodate your request.

2. **Be Prompt and Present!** Students, you are responsible for reporting to the office when you are tardy, and for ensuring your absences are excused within 24 hours. Remind your parents to call 619-522-8907 x2094 or bring a signed note (click here for our new reporting form) to the attendance office.
3. **Represent!** All students and staff will be issued a Student ID Card and lanyard. For reasons of safety and security, we will all be required to wear IDs during the school day. ID cards are required for admission to CHS dances and other activities. ID Card replacement cost is \$25.00.
4. **Dress for Success!** Our business is education, and we ask that students dress appropriately for the business of school by wearing comfortable clothes which comply with our dress code. 5. **Bond with Fellow Freshmen at Lunch!** While sophomores, juniors, and seniors are permitted to leave campus for lunch, the campus is closed for freshmen in order to acclimate 9th graders to their peers, staff, and resources on campus. ALL students remain on campus during the daily nutrition break in the morning. See you on the quad!
6. **Buy Your ASB Card!** The CHS ASB card saves you money in discounts or free admission to student events and activities (<http://chs.coronadousd.net/about-chs/2013-2014-studentparent-handbook/>) and raises money for ASB organizations. ASB cards cost \$45 dollars for the first student and \$40 dollars per additional family member.

7. **Keep Pace with Grades!** Progress reports are issued at the first and third quarters, with official report cards sent out at the end of each semester. Final exams are held the last week of each semester:
- Aug 21 to Oct 10: 1st Quarter
Oct 14 to Dec 18: 2nd Quarter / End of Fall Semester
Jan 5 to March 6: 3rd Quarter
March 9 to June 10: 4th Quarter / End of Spring Semester
- Students at risk of receiving a failing grade in any course will receive a Deficiency Notice after Oct. 24th and Mar. 20th. Students and parents are encouraged to access Haiku regularly for assignments and progress in classes.
